An Introductory Note

The series of photoalbums THE VOYAGER summarizes in images Florentin Smarandache's voyages around the globe.

This second volume briefly depicts voyages in North America (Canada and United States of America, with a special emphasis on Gallup, NM, and surroundings, town that hosts the University of New Mexico, where Florentin Smarandache teaches Math for almost two decades), Asia (Taiwan - People's Republic of China), South America (Federative Republic of Brazil, Plurinational State of Bolivia, Republic of Ecuador, Republic of Chile), and Europe (England, Scotland, Kingdom of Spain, Kingdom of Belgium, France, Federal Republic of Germany, Kingdom of Sweden, Confédération Suisse, Hungary, Republic of Moldova, and Romania, with a special emphasis on the last, Florentin Smarandache's home country).

The photographs are arranged chronologically in subchapters, and date back as far as 1991; a legend indicating the month, year, and location is added to all photographs.

Neutrosophic Logic generalizes many Logics

Let the components reduced to scalar numbers, t, i, f, with $t+i+f=1$. NL generalizes:

- the **Boolean logic** (for $n=1$ and $i=0$, with t, f either 0 or 1)
- the **multi-valued logic**, which supports the existence of many values between true and false [Łukasiewicz, 3 values; Post, many values] (for $n=1, i=0, 0 \leq t, f \leq 1$);
- the **intuitionistic logic**, which supports incomplete theories, i.e. there exist x such that $P(x)$ is true, not always true, and $\neg P(x)$ is not always false [Brouwer, 1907] (for $0 \leq n < 1$ and $i=0, 0 \leq t, f < 1$);
- the **fuzzy logic**, which supports degrees of truth [Zadeh, 1965] (for $n=1$ and $i=0, 0 \leq t, f \leq 1$);
- the **intuitionistic fuzzy logic**, which supports degrees of truth and degrees of falsity while what's left is considered indeterminacy [Atanasiu, 1982] (for $n=1$).
