ESSAY FORMATING OPTIONS:

Typed Essay

- 2—3pages
- Header should include full name, school, grade level
- 12 point font
- Double-Spaced
- Legible font style—example: Times New Roman, Calibri, Arial, etc.

Handwritten Essay

- 2-3 pages
- Header should include full name, school, grade level
- Printed in Blue or Black Ink
- Double-Spaced
- White 8.5x11 line notebook paper

DIRECTIONS: In a short essay, please respond to the following:

- Who are you, and what shapes your identity? (family, culture, values, or life experiences)
- What kind of support helps you succeed? Who or what do you turn to when things get hard?
- Why do you want to be part of TRIO Upward Bound, and what do you hope to gain from it?
- TRIO requires students to attend Saturday Seminars and monthly advisement meetings. Can you commit to showing up regularly? What would that commitment look like for you?
- Share one challenge you've faced and how you dealt with it. What did you learn about yourself?
