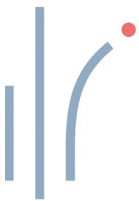

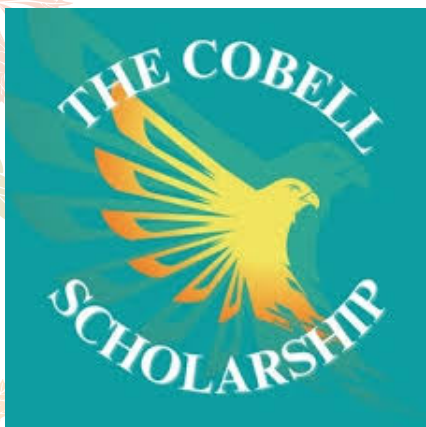
SOCIETY FOR AMERICAN ARCHAEOLOGY

ARIZONA PROMISE PROGRAM

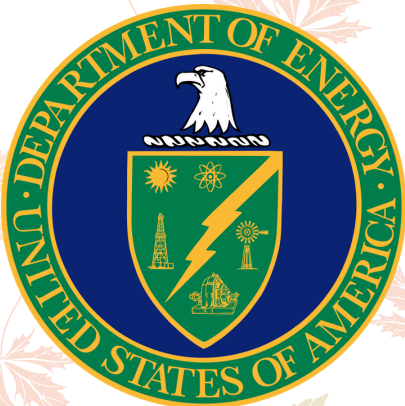
The Arizona Promise Program is a guaranteed scholarship program for eligible Arizona residents that ensures all tuition and fees are covered at Arizona's public universities.

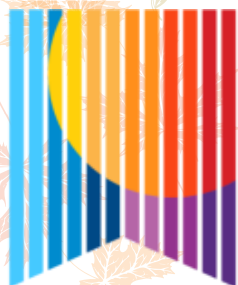
