Discussion/Action Items:

Staff Council T Shirt Quotes – Richard Reyes: gave spreadsheet, would like to use remaining staff council funds before fiscal year ends to purchase t-shirts. Found approved UNM licensed vendors and received quotes. Some are less expensive which will be cheaper in quality, links provided on spreadsheet to look at t-shirts. Mr. Teez is an official license vendor located in Gallup, can buy promotional items, awaiting quote. Contacted University teams and received a quick reply; simple design UNM logo with Staff Council on them, can be flashy and have a stenciled building of Gurley Hall. Frank Question: Minimum quantity? Response: Yes. Some have a large quantity minimum and some might not have minimum quantity. Richard Reyes can answer any questions about t-shirts. Planning to give T-shirts to new employees for welcome goody bags. Council bought water bottles and gave to new employees, one or two years ago. HR would give the t-shirt to new employees or could be given to current employees. Corporate structure: did you know that a shirt with a logo on it employees are 50% most likely to stay employed more than a year, then 80 to 90% if it has just text. Staff Council agrees with t-shirt idea for new and existing employees. Planning to go with a company that can do small quantities. Can have a stock of shirts waiting for new employees. T-shirt budget can be added to the budget list.
