"Hot wash" was performed that same day as well. Hot wash explanation: what was done well and what was not during evacuation then set an action plan. Safety meeting next week. Referring to fixing Vo-tech Drive traffic paint and signs have been ordered. It's decided the road will be a one way in and out.



Safety week planning subcommittee has more participants than ever before. Safety walk will be happening soon, you can join after work to walk campus to see what needs to be fixed or addressed. Look at entire property so findings can be taken to the executive team. Creating contact list for emergency services. Lobo Guardian, Rave or Shield, is what UNM Gallup could be transitioned to (new alert system). Gates installed all around campus so people will stay out during the night. License plate readers: Gallup PD has new readers that will now capture license plate and photo of driver who is speeding.
