Our program provides academic & individual support services for low-income and/or potential first - generation to college students. All Upward Bound program activities and services are free to students enrolled in the program.



WHAT DOES IT COST?

There is absolutely NO COST to students or their families. This is a FREE federal program that provides FREE activities and services to all eligible students accepted into the program.

- 9th -11th grade enrolled at Hiroshi Miyamura High School or McKinley Academy with HMHS home school
- First Generation to College
- Meets low-income requirements determined by the Department of Education
- U.S Citizen or a Permanent Resident
- A need for academic support services
- Interested in enrolling in a 2-4 year college or university after graduating from high school

- Complete the application packet with signatures
- Attach 3 teacher & counselor recommendation forms
- Attach 1-2 page essay
- Attach copy of recent tax form for income verification

Submit completed application packet to the TRIO Upward Bound office at the UNM - Gallup campus, or scan & email packet to unmgub@gmail.com; or mail packet to address found on the back of brochure. Application packets may also be submitted via fax with ATTN: TRIO Upward Bound.

Applications will be reviewed and admission decision will be determined within 2 weeks of submission. Student along with parent/guardian will be contacted for an intake interview within this time frame at which a final admission decision will be made. Students will be notified via phone and/or email.

Upward Bound was the first federal TRIO program funded through the U.S Department of Education in 1964.

A total of 8 TRIO programs provide outreach and student services programs designed to identify and provide services for individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds. TRIO programs specifically serve and assist low-income individuals, first-generation to college students, and/or individuals with documented disabilities to progress through the academic pipeline from middle school to post baccalaureate programs.

There are hundreds of Upward Bound programs throughout the United States. serving low-income and first-generation to college high school students with the primary goal of increasing the secondary education graduation rate, the postsecondary institution admission and attendance rate, and ultimately increasing the percentage and rate of participants graduating with a college degree.
