#### **AGENDA ITEM I: CALL TO ORDER**

- A. Chairman Ralph Richards called the November 19, 2024 regular meeting of the UNM-Gallup Local Advisory Board to order at 4:03 PM with roll call. A quorum was present.
- B. Motion was made by Board Member Apel to approve the UNM-Gallup Local Advisory Board Agenda as presented. Motion was seconded by Board Member Calderon and approved by unanimous roll call vote at 4:04 PM.

### AGENDA ITEM VI: EXECUTIVE TEAM'S REPORT

#### Chancellors Report | Dr. Sabrina Ezzell

- A. UNMG Strategic Plan Chancellor Ezzell gave an overview of the 5 areas of the strategic plan, which are #1. Student Experience – Educational Innovation, #2. Sustainability, #3. One Campus, #4. Inclusive Excellence and #5. Advancing Our Communities. Jayme McMahon is the team leader for Goal #1, the Student Experience. Ms. McMahon stated the group has 4 goals and each goal has various tactics. She spoke on the gains/progress that has been made within each goal/objective. Chancellor Ezzell spoke on Goal #2 -Sustainability, to which she is the team leader: The focus has been on how to increase our funding above our appropriations from the state. Through our partnership with the UNM Foundation, we will be engaging in 2 campaigns. These are the "UNM Giving Day" which is on 12/3/24 and "UNM Big Give" on 2/12/25. Those 2 campaigns will involve the Foundation emailing the 400 existing donors to UNM-Gallup along with a letter from the Chancellor that will list what UNM-Gallup is fundraising for, which includes money for a food pantry, student support services and equipment for the CCTE area that is currently being renovated. Chairman Richards asked if we are recruiting new donors. Per Chancellor Ezzell, she is working with the UNM Alumni group and the Foundation. Goal #3 - One Campus, with Dean Zimmerman as the leader of this group. One of the objectives is to improve the onboarding at UNM-Gallup and to make our campus more welcoming for faculty and staff. New faculty attend an orientation in addition to a tour of campus, introductions, and a welcome packet. New staff employees work closely with Human Resources, they also attend a meet-n-greet with Chancellor Ezzell and the Staff Council executive committee members. We have also improved our Employee Recognition program, "Kudos" which employees recognize each other. We have implemented a recognition event to which employees who received a Kudos in the previous quarter are invited. Goal #4 – Inclusive Excellence is led by team leader, Richard Reyes. Recent areas have been accessibility and celebrating diversity. They are currently working on developing questions for listening sessions to gather broad input on accessibility needs across campus. A calendar to celebrate diversity was also created which events for Hispanic Heritage month, Native American Heritage month, Veterans Day, Black History & Women's History month, Asian American & Pacific Islander Heritage month, and LGBTQ+ Campus Pride month as well as many other events that support mental and physical health. #5, Advancing Our Communities group is led by Frank Sanchez. The group is also working on an Alumni event in the spring. They are also working to identify formal and informal working relationships that currently exist between UNM-Gallup and contacts within our community that come from Public Safety, Media, Education, Healthcare, Business and Government.
- B. Legislative Session No update on the unified priorities but we are asking for a 4% pay increase next fiscal year for staff and faculty. Appropriations for compensation are paid at 80% to which UNM-Gallup must produce the remaining 20%. Chairman Richards asked what would the 20% be for UNM-Gallup, and this translates to approximately \$200,000. Board Member Hanks asked if this would be on average or a straightforward 4%. Per Chancellor Ezzell, it could be either, but we give it to everyone. HED report



- suggested that they will recommend that we get a 1.8% increase to our base which amounts to \$195,00 and this will put us right at the level that we need to fund the salary increases. We will know what UNM-Gallup will receive after the Governor signs legislation.
- C. Police Academy Chancellor Ezzell recently met with Representative Patty Lundstrom and she has started the process to get a bill written for the legislative session to fund a police academy. Details for the bill are being put together and things are moving in the right direction. If approved, we could receive money in July 2025.
- D. Student Experience Capital Project The renovation of Gurley Hall is from the GO Bond '22 which the funding was originally \$3 million with a \$725,000 match. We went back and asked for a \$1.5 million supplemental, which we obtained. This in total is still not enough, as our estimated costs of the renovation is around \$12 million, so we have cut out some options and will be done in phases. Phase 1 will include renovating our departmental spaces on the East side of Gurley Hall, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor and the basement which houses Adult Basic Education, which our current funding will cover. The Commons area will have to wait until phase 2. Phase 1 will include a round-about in the front of Gurley Hall to promote safety.
- E. Governor Lujan-Grisham's Town Hall Meeting 12/3/24 UNM-Gallup will be hosting the Governor's Public Safety Town Hall Meeting in the Calvin Hall Auditorium on Tuesday, 12/3/24 from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm. Logistics have been in the planning phase for approximately 1 month. She is hosting 4 Town Hall meetings and Gallup was chosen as one of the 4 sites.

#### Academic Affairs | Mr. John Zimmerman, Dean of Instruction

- A. Math, Physical and Natural Sciences Dr. Arunachalam Muthaiyan Delivered a speech at Pondicherry University and provided a training to the students in a workshop. Anti-Microbial Resistance Mechanism of the Gut
- B. Fine Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences Dr. Chris Dyer presented at the Annual Natural Hazards Center Workshop in Boulder; Dr. Bruce Gjeltema presented at the Western History Association Annual Conference in Kansas City; Dr. Yi-Wen Huang presented at the 19th Conference on Translation, Interpreting, LSPs and Cultural Studies in Poznan, Poland; Dr. Tracy Lassiter presented at the Framing the Unreal Conference in Venice, Italy; Dr. Aretha Matt presented at the National Institute for Native Leadership in Wilmington, NC; Dr. Matthew Mingus presented at the Society for the History of Discoveries in San Antonio; and Dr. Yuqing Zou virtually presented a paper to the American Psychological Association. Professor Joe Kee is currently working with other colleagues across New Mexico and Arizona on a Navajo Government textbook. Dr. Carolyn Kuchera will have an article on Simon Ortiz published next year in the Journal of the Southwest. Liverpool University Press will soon be publishing an article about Flann O'Brien written by Dr. Andrew McFeaters. Dr. Keri Stevenson is currently on sabbatical, wrapping up two manuscripts that are both under contract with publishers: a first-year composition textbook entitled Closer to the Sun: Clarity and Strategy in First-Year Composition and Entangled and Empowered: Agency in Multispecies Communities. Lecturer III Kristi Wilson's artwork recently returned from an exhibition at the Society of North American Goldsmith's conference in San Diego and is currently on display during New York Jewelry Week.
- C. Education, Health & Human Services Division As of Q3 (third quarter), our NCLEX-RN first-time pass rate for the AAS in Nursing is 100%. We have a total of 12 students who have taken and passed the NCLEX-RN on their first attempt from Jan 1, 2024, until Sep 30, 2024. We will know



- by Jan 2025, on our AAS in Nursing final pass rate for the calendar year 2024. Division Chair Dr. Gambill was successful in securing two years of funding to cover a full-time faculty position in Community Health Worker which works hand-in-hand with our Human Services program through the state funded Research and Public Service Project program.
- D. UNM College of Education and Human Sciences has secured funding for and is advertising a full-time faculty position, to be based at UNM-Gallup, to serve students interested in bachelor's level education courses.

#### Student Affairs | Jayme McMahon, Director of Student Affairs

- A. Strategic Planning The Student Affairs Operations Team has been focused on the strategic objectives and tasks that support Goal One: Student Experience and Education Innovation. Staffing updates include the onboarding of a new TRIO/Upward Bound Director, Donovan Chee who has been employed with TRIO/SSS. We will be hiring Student Success Specialists, and the search committee currently has approximately 15 candidates and will interview within the next week and a half. There are 5 positions to fill, 3 of which are replacements and 2 new positions. Two of these positions will be supporting our new Native American Student Success Center. The Admissions office is now fully staffed, which includes a new full-time Admissions Advisor. These have all been identified as hiring needs to support strategic priorities.
- B. Strategic Enrollment Management a report was submitted to HED on 10/11/24. This detailed the enrollment trends over the last 5 years, identified our target populations which is primarily our non-traditional adult learners, as well as Native American students. We have seen a decline in both populations even since the pre-pandemic, and more so during. We are currently seeing increases. In 2022 we had to identify enrollment targets and we have already exceeded those targets. In our report we also detailed the work that the Dean has been doing with Academic Affairs in our academic programs and the new program initiatives we are working on, as well as our non-credit areas to better reach the workforce needs of the area.
- C. Student Affairs Events A College Transfer and Scholarship Fair was held on 10/16/24 which included 25-35 educational institutions/agencies to provide resources to students who are interested in a bachelor's program or entering into the workforce. UNM-Gallup partnered with the NM Workforce Solutions to have the "Be Pro Be Proud" big rig here on campus for 2 days. The Student Affairs held a staff retreat on 10/24/24 and all of the offices of Student Affairs were closed in order to engage in Professional Development with all of Student Affairs. On 11/18/24 we completed a federal Veterans Affairs site visit and compliance audit. We successfully passed with a few minor issues to address just because of staffing transitions. We will receive the formal report in the next 30 days.
- D. Student Activities Our Student Activities & Recreational Office along with other campus departments hosted a successful Welcome Back event series for students in the Fall. They also hosted a Halloween Carnival on campus for the community. They are trying to get the intermurals up and running again. A Veteran's Day Recognition event was also held campus. A successful series of events to support and honor Native American Heritage month were also held. One of the events was hosted by the Navajo Nation, who did a presentation on water rights, water issues and settlements, as well as



- the work that the tribe is doing with Washington in that effort.
- E. Student Government –We are working on getting students into offices of Student Government by Spring. We recently put the information out there but there were not any students interested and this has always been a challenge. McKinley Academy and Middle College High School are also invited to participate. New clubs will also be created, and Student Affairs will support that effort, as well as continue to work on student leadership.

#### Business Operations | Mr. Robert Griego, Director of Business Operations

- A. Robert Griego gave an overview on how UNM-Gallup is funded due to questions by the Local Advisory Board. The HED has a funding formula which determines what each institution will receive, which is I&G money. Salary compensation is a separate state appropriation which state legislation determines the amount that we will receive and varies from year to year. We also get funding from other areas besides I&G such as restricted programs receive outside funding and we get special appropriations. This year we received a one-time BR&R (Building Renewal & Replacement) funding of \$300,000. Student tuition also generates a little bit of our revenue as well.
- B. Mr. Griego presented the UNMG Campus Summary of Current and Plant Fund Report: Period 4. Mr. Griego stated that we are on track. Board Member Hanks requested the schedule that shows salary encumbrances to the reports. Board Member Calderon also requested that page numbers be added to the Campus Summary of Current and Plant Fund Reports and if they can get more detailed reports.

### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

#### A. Public Relations Overview:

- 1. Holiday in New Mexico Richard Reyes gave an update on the upcoming annual community event, Holiday in New Mexico, which is scheduled to be held on Thursday, 12/5/24 at 5:30 pm. The event will have music by faculty member, JP Van Derdys and solo performances by Rehoboth and Hozo Academy students.
- 2. Student Work Study starts tomorrow in Public Relations so the department will have some additional help.
- 3. Luminaria Publication Richard Reyes has created a new publication for UNM-Gallup to promote the campus with news stories, events, and enrollments. 8500 copies were printed with approximately eight thousand of them being mailed out to community residents. The Executive Team has been very supportive of this publication.
- B. Middle College High School: Dr. Robert Hunter, CEO gave an update on the MCHS new construction. The walls of the building are currently going up. The construction company had to re-order some steel which had construction on hold for 3 weeks. MCHS notified the builder that they would advance them an additional \$1 million if they could have it constructed by Fall 2025, and they stated they felt that they could do that.
