EXECUTIVE TEAM'S REPORT



Chancellors Report | Dr. Sabrina Ezzell

- A. Capital Projects –The CTE renovations are moving along including the Welding Technology Program and will be completed within the next 2 weeks. The Automotive Technology Program renovations will also begin very soon, with some possible overlap between the two projects. The Gurley Student Experience planning phase is 90% complete, and the architects met with the stakeholders last week, it is moving along very well. There was discussion regarding the start date of this project due to the construction currently taking place with the new McKinley Academy building and the concerns with traffic congestion/loss of parking spaces. Since the Student Experience project starts in the parking lot, a decision was made to hold off on starting this until the new building is almost complete, the target for that is mid-August 2026. The student Experience project is estimated to start the summer 2026 with a little bit of overlap since this is the slowest time on campus. This will help to avoid more issues and not have a huge impact on traffic flow. The next project will be renovations in the Art department since the GO Bond was passed. Chancellor Ezzell has reached out to Facilities & Design Construction Office to assign a planner. Also, the architects that are working on the Student Experience are also working on the feasibility study for the Calvin Hall – North renovation. Therefore, there will be estimates for that project in the next 2-3 weeks.
- B. Gallup McKinley County Day Chancellor Ezzell stated that the Gallup-McKinley County Day planning committee has already started meeting and have selected February 4th & 5th, 2026 for the Governor's meeting and event day. No timeframes for the events nor host hotels have been identified yet, as this is in the early phase of planning.

Academic Affairs | Mr. John Zimmerman, Dean of Instruction

- A. Common Course Numbering The UNM-Gallup campus has been steadily working on renumbering class courses, which is a statewide initiative. This is to structure all classes to be similar across the state with the same title and same course number so that students can navigate their college journey via transcripts to the next school, so they correlate. This will be across all academic areas.
- B. Education Dept. Update Board Member Vian asked for an update on the Education department and how things are progressing in that area. Per Dean Zimmerman, there have been meetings with the Albuquerque campus. UNM-Gallup currently has a full-time faculty member overseeing the program and an Albuquerque faculty member housed at UNMG who is offering the bachelor degree courses, as well as our existing education faculty members who offer the undergraduate certificate courses that lead up to the bachelor courses. UNM-Gallup also has an alternative licensure program going and there is an MOU so everyone understands the process.

Student Affairs \Jayme McMahon, Director of Student Affairs

A. Enrollment Report – Jayme McMahon, Director of Student Affairs was not in attendance so a brief report on Enrollment Census was given by Dean of Instruction, John Zimmerman. Student Campus, which are Gallup students, has increased 4.15% which is equivalent to 71 more students than this same time last year. Since Fall 2023 we have increased 8.39%. As for Course Campus, students taking courses at the Gallup branch but are from the Albuquerque, Taos, Los Alamos, Valencia and Gallup locations - there has been a 13.8% increase since this time last year. This is equal to 387 students.



Since Fall 2025 we have had a 20.87% increase, which is substantial. The last metric is Student Credit Hours and since last year we have increased 9.78%, which amounts to 1,817 credit hours. Since Fall 2023 we have increased this by 17.92%. According to all of the above metrics, we have steadily increased in all areas for the last several years. Board Member Vian asked if there is a way to distinguish between our growth and the other UNM locations, as well as how we compare. Per Chancellor Ezzell, the largest factor is the Albuquerque campus. Out of the 2,802 students enrolled this semester, 869 are from Albuquerque. There are 84 students from Valencia, 84 from Valencia, 49 from Los Alamos and 31 from Taos. Valenica normally ends up with the higher number of Albuquerque students. Chairman Calderon asked how this impacts our capacity. Per Dean Zimmerman, this always presents a challenge but there is no downside to adding more classes if we have the faculty to teach them. UNM-Gallup has been able to keep up with the demand.

Business Operations | Mr. Robert Griego, Director of Business Operations

- A. UNMG Campus Summary of Current and Plant Fund Report: Period 2 Mr. Griego presented an overview of the UNMG Campus Summary of Current and Plant Fund Report: Period 2. Each set of financial statements conveys the comparison to the same month last year and are generally comparable. Once again, the numbers support the fact that the census is up at UNMG.
- B. UNM-Gallup FY25 Mil Levy Report Per the request of Board Member Hanks, Mr. Griego presented a Mil Levy report that answered the growth factor question at the last meeting. The New Mexico statue states that taxes cannot go up more than 5% over the total value of the increased value attributable to new evaluations (new properties). If property values are increasing at a fast pace, this limits the growth control of the amount paid in property taxes. There are some exceptions that can change the property taxes such as veteran status, etc.

AGENDA ITEM VII: NEW BUSINESS

- A. Action Item: Vote and Sign UNM-Gallup Local Advisory Board Bylaws Discussion to the amendments to the Local Advisory Board Bylaws took place at the last regular meeting on August 19, 2025. Motion was made to accept the newly amended Bylaws was made by Board Member Vian. The Motion was seconded by Board Member Apel. A toll call vote was taken with the following outcome:
 - Chairperson Calderon voted Yes; Board Member Apel voted Yes; Board Member Vian voted Yes; There was no discussion or opposition therefore the motion to accept the amended Bylaws was voted on and approved at 5:11 pm.
- B. Discuss Format of Financial Reporting Chairman Calderon requested that there be less of the accounting each month and more periodical forecasting reporting. Mr. Griego suggested reporting on big picture categories with graphs, financial forecasting and trends as well as how this compares to past years. Mr. Griego will revise the hard copies of financial reporting to condense the proposed, revised and actual budget numbers into a smaller, less detailed reporting format. He also stated that all financial schedules are posted to the UNM-Gallup Business Operations webpage.

2024-2025 UNM-Gallup Findings Report



A Lobo Well-Being Project

SUMMARY

The UNM Student Well-Being Assessment was completed in Fall 2024 in partnership with the American College Health Association (ACHA). 4,704 UNM students participated in the survey, which investigated areas of well-being, known as "dimensions", that are influenced by the college environment. Please refer to the *Student Well-Being Assessment: 2024-2025 Findings Report* for information regarding ACHA's dimensions and correlation to the University's Lobo Well-Being framework.

This supplemental report references terminology specific to the American College Health Association's Well-Being Assessment. Definitions of Trans/GNC, Dimensions, and the use of sex and gender are included in the 2024-2025 Findings Report.


DEMOGRAPHICS

According to the UNM Office of Institutional Analytics (OIA) Official Enrollment Report (OER), the total Gallup Campus Headcount for Fall 2024 was 1,692 students. Of that total, 172 students participated in the Student Well-Being Assessment, resulting in a response rate of just over 10%. Please note that students participating in dual-credit and concurrent enrollment were not included in the Student Well-Being Assessment. Approximately 59% of Gallup's Fall 2024 headcount was female, while 40% were male. OIA does not currently track transgender or gender non-conforming identities in the OFR.



Students at the Gallup campus generally reported more desirable dimension scores than their peers at All Other Branches and Central (Main) Campus, scoring more desirably in eleven of the fourteen dimensions. Gallup scored within +/- 1.00 of all other branches in the Positive Coping and Purpose dimensions, while Central Campus scored highest in the Activity Engagement dimension. See Figure 2.

Students at Gallup with Disabilities or Conditions generally report less desirable scores in many dimensions compared to their peers. Queer-Spectrum students reported less desirable scores in eight dimensions compared to their peers, though scores were similar to their peers' scores—or even slightly better—in Loneliness, Social Anxiety, Optimism, Activity Engagement, Academic Engagement, and Purpose. The number of Trans/GNC respondents at Gallup was too low for comparison.

Cis Men scored more desirably than any other population at Gallup (excluding the BIPOC category, which drives the mean) in eleven of the fourteen dimensions. This contrasts with Central Campus, where Parenting Students reported the most desirable scores.



Mental Health and Access to Care

Figure 3. Gallup Students' Mental Health and Access to Care



38.4% of students at Gallup report having at least one disability or condition



39.5% of students at Gallup cannot currently afford to obtain mental health care if needed.



34.3% of students at Gallup cannot currently afford to obtain medical care if needed.

Fewer students at Gallup report having at least one disability or condition than the average of students at all campuses (38.4% vs. 57.9%). However, 6.2% more students at Gallup cannot currently afford medical care if needed while 8.2% more cannot currently afford mental health care if needed. This indicates that students at Gallup may face greater barriers to care than the average UNM student. See Figure 3.

Within the last 30 days, 57% of students at Gallup indicated the food they bought did not last, and they did not have money to get more (vs. an average of 31.4%). 48.9% of Gallup students also reported sometimes/often/very often contributing money to support family members, vs. a UNM-wide average of 26.3%. Students at Gallup also appear to worry about paying for their educational expenses slightly more than the average UNM student (60.4% vs. 56.4%). See Figure 4.

CONSIDERATIONS

In addition to the Considerations highlighted in the 2024-2025 Findings Report, please note that, due to the number of responses, care should be taken when

reviewing these data. With a response number of 172, Gallup met the desired 10% response rate, but sub-population data may not be fully representative of the Gallup student body. Additionally, some sub-populations including Veterans and Trans/GNC students have been excluded from further analysis due to the risk of identification. Lastly, research requirements have mandated that students under the age of 18 be excluded from this assessment. Given the composition of UNM's Branch Campuses in general, it is important to remember that these data apply *only* to students 18 years of age or older.

Economic Forecast: U.S. Outlook

U.S. GDP growth is moderating; inflation remains above 2% through FY27.

The labor market has grown at a solid pace, though recent data suggests slowing and signs of weakness.

The 12-month change in the consumer price index (CPI) increased by 2.7% in July and core CPI rose 3.1%.

Significant uncertainty in the economic outlook remains. Neither S&P Global nor Moody's Analytics include a recession in their baseline forecast.



Economic Forecast: New Mexico Outlook

The estimates used in the consensus revenue forecast expect the New Mexico economy will grow at a slower rate than the U.S. economy throughout the forecast period.

Employment

- BBER expects employment growth to steadily slow, increasing 0.9% in 2025 before dipping to 0.2% in 2026 and stabilizing around 0.4% in 2029.
- BBER expects New Mexico's labor force will expand by 0.7 percent in 2025 compared with 2024, with annual growth expected to tick downward to 0.3 percent in 2026 and beyond.

Wages and Salaries

- Total wages and salaries grew by 6.3 percent in 2024, a slowdown from the pandemic recovery period but still well above historical annual growth rates.
- BBER expects average yearover-year growth in total personal income to be 4.9 percent from 2025 to 2030.

Oil and Gas

- Over the past several years, New Mexico's oil and natural gas industry has experienced significant growth, more than quintupling since 2017 (441% growth).
- Oil production is already experiencing a slowdown, even though moderate growth is expected throughout the forecast.
- New Mexico's natural gas production boom has begun to slow as well, although not at the same rate as oil.

Forecast Risks

- Oil and Natural Gas Market Dynamics
 - New Mexico's reliance on the oil and gas industry continues to make commodity price volatility the most significant risk to the general fund forecast.
- Recession Risks
 - The most recent survey of business and academic economists polled by the Wall Street Journal in July put the risk of a U.S. recession at 33%, down from 45% in April but up from the end of 2024.
 - A recession would dampen wages and salaries and consumer spending, posing serious downside risks to both income tax and GRT collections.



Forecast Risks (continued)

Inflation

- Inflation poses both direct upside and downside risks for state revenue.
- Although inflation rates remain well below their pandemic-era peaks and recent risks have moderated, some upward pressure persists.

Revenue Volatility


- Rising revenue volatility has complicated state revenue forecasting and challenged state budgetary planning.
- The state has expanded its efforts to stabilize revenues by creating distributions of some windfall oil and gas collections.
- New sources of revenue volatility have emerged, like New Mexico's corporate income tax revenues.




Core Fund Plan Forecast Risks

- Reliance on state funding goes beyond state appropriations, as tuition revenue is also partially funded through Lottery and Opportunity Scholarships funded by the state.
- Enrollment dynamics impact both revenue and costs
 - As enrollment increases, institutions often face higher operational costs, whether from rising administrative expenses, the need for more faculty, or the need for expanded student services
 - Long term outlook of enrollment trends and impact on budgeting
- Due to reliance on state funding, general fund forecast risks also impact core fund forecast risks:
 - Oil & Gas Market Dynamics, Recession Risks, Inflation, and Revenue Volatility

Comparion of Reserves to Other Branches




NMHED Fall Enrollment Dashboard


