<u> Application Criteria:</u>

Applications must be completed in black or blue ink pen. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Scholarship amounts vary depending on the availability of funds. Scholarship awards may be offered for one semester and/or academic year, check scholarship for requirements.

Selection Process:

The scholarship committee reviews qualified applicants based on financial need, academic merit, and other criteria relevant to the particular endowment. Selection is based on a Point System Assessment of GPA, Essay, Letters of Recommendation and all other attachments. Once the selection process is complete, students are notified via UNM email.

<u>Checklist:</u>

For a complete application, the following are required:

- Endowment Scholarship Application
 - Typed Essay (The following questions <u>are only examples</u> to help shape your essay)
 - * Personal: Brief Introduction
 - Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart. Describe your most meaningful achievements and how they relate to your field of study Why are you a good candidate to receive this award? Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability both in and out of school.
 - Choose a person or persons you admire and explain why.

* Academics: Future plans and goals

Briefly describe your long- and short-term goals. What strengths do you have that will help you achieve your goals? Describe your weaknesses and how will you overcome them? Why do you want to get a college education?

* Financial Need:

From a financial standpoint, what impact would this scholarship have on your education? State any special personal or family circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance. How have you been financing your college education?

- Letter of Recommendation (Typed in a sealed envelope, 6-month period, recommendation should be from a faculty, staff, counselor, or someone in a professional capacity, family recommendations will not be considered)
- Unofficial college transcript
- Check scholarship for all other requirements.
