Greetings to our UNM-Gallup campus community. I hope that these remaining weeks of summer are joyful for you as we inch our way toward the start of the fall semester, coming up soon on August 23rd. In anticipation of that date, I'd like to walk you through some important milestones, events, and reminders that we should be aware of as we return to campus.

**UNM-Gallup Student Return Guide**

To be helpful to our students, who are receiving a lot of new information right now, we've published a one-stop return guide in our UNM-Gallup newsroom that covers most, if not all, of the bases for the upcoming fall semester. Inside this guide, we've posted information that includes:

- An update to the UNM-Gallup mask policy. With revised CDC data, wearing a face mask indoors is now required throughout campus. A mask is not required outdoors and on the fitness trail unless you are not vaccinated.
- The very important UNM vaccine requirement and information on how to submit your proof of vaccination or submit a request for accommodation for those with certain medical conditions or sincere religious beliefs that would prohibit them from getting a vaccine.
- New Zollinger Library and bookstore hours of operation and how to access online services and requests. Bookstore charging runs now through Friday, August 16th.
- This week's New Student Orientation schedule and how to take the mandatory "Grey Area" sexual misconduct prevention training; and
- How to access student affairs for admission, advisement, registration, financial aid, and other important student services.
