

# EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

## EMT BASIC COURSE

Thank you for your interest in the EMT Basic course at UNM-Gallup. We have put together important information about the EMT Basic Certificate Program and a checklist to guide you through obtaining your requirements for the EMT Basic Course.

#### 1. Structure of the EMT Basic Program

- a. Required to view the EMS Information Session video <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mTtGJJT--58&feature=youtu.be</u>
- b. Course Fees are paid to the EMS Academy (\$184.00\*). This is in addition to the tuition and course fees.
- c. Register for EMS 113 (lecture) & EMS 142 (lab).
- d. Attend Mandatory EMS Orientation
- e. Clinical/Field rotation is required and is a continuation of the EMT Basic Course (up to 4 weeks and will vary on student progress).
- f. Course Completion Certificate is earned with completion of all three sections (as stated in (c) and (e).
- g. National Registry (NREMT) Exam/Requirements
  - i. Completion verification of all three sections (EMSA will provide this information).
  - ii. Submit Application and payment (\$80.00\*)
  - iii. When approved, you will select a date and location with Pearson Vue.
- h. State Certification
  - i. Successfully pass the NREMT Exam and obtain license.
  - ii. Submit application, fee (\$65.00\*), Background check, current BLS CPR card, and present your NREMT Certification.

#### 2. Program Expectations

- a. Strict Attendance requirements. <u>Cannot</u> miss more than 12 hours.
- b. Must pass <u>all</u> Block Exams with a 73% or better.
- c. Requires several hours per week of out of class study time.
- d. Tests are completed online during class.
- e. Clinical/Field can be an additional 4 weeks upon completion of EMS 113 and EMS 142.
- f. Uniform & Equipment Requirements
  - i. Navy blue or black workpants (no jeans), Black polo shirt, and black boots.
  - ii. Stethoscope
  - iii. Second hand watch
  - iv. Trauma Scissors
  - v. Black Belt
  - vi. pen light
  - vii. UNM Student Badge

### EMT Basic Requirement Checklist ALL WILL NEED TO BE SENT BY EMAIL

\*<u>All requirements are to be completed and submitted 14 days after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of class</u> begins.\*

- Current CPR- Healthcare Provider Level Card
- Current Driver's License or State Issued Picture ID Card
- Current Health Insurance Card
  - Medicaid is an acceptable insurance.
  - If you are registered with a Native American Tribe and you utilize the I.H.S. facility for all your medical care and emergencies; a letter stating this and proof of your registered membership will be accepted as your Health Insurance.
    - Contact Sonya Damon for the Letter Template.
- □ 10-Panel Illegal Drug Urinalysis
  - Testing can be performed no more than 30 days prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of class.
  - Takes 7 10 days for the results.
  - Can be performed at:

**RMCH- College Clinic- (505) 863-7000 Indian Health Services (your area I.H.S.):** selected service. Not all I.H.S. facilities will provide this service.

- Completed Background Check (\$73.30)
  - Requisition for Background check will be given during the EMS Orientation.
  - DO NOT PERFORM BEFORE PRIOR TO THE EMS ORIENTATION.
- □ Immunizations (see attached Immunization Requirements for UNM Students in Healthcare Programs)
  - <u>Records must have the name of the facility where immunizations</u> were administered.

PLEASE PROVIDE ALL AND ANY DOCUMENTATIONS (RESULTS, ANYTHING WITH SINATURES, RECEIPTS, LAB ORDER FORMS, etc.) SHOWING IN PROGRESS TO SONYADAMON, EMS DIRECTOR.
