EMT Intermediate COURSE

Thank you for your interest in the EMT Intermediate course at UNM-Gallup. We have put together important information about the EMT Intermediate Certificate Program and a checklist to guide you through obtaining your requirements for the EMT Intermediate Course.

1. Structure of the EMT Intermediate Program

- a. Current NM EMT Basic License (Pre-requisite).
- b. Required to view the EMS Information Session video

- c. Course Fees: EMS Academy (\$184.00*) & Lab Fee (\$20.00).
- d. Register for EMS 180, EMS 143, and EMS 151.
- e. Course Completion Certificate will be earned upon completion of all three courses.
- g. National Registry (NREMT) Exam/Requirements
 - i. Completion verification of all three sections (EMSA will provide this information).
 - ii. Submit Application and payment (\$115.00*) to NREMT.
 - iii. When approved, you will select a date and location with Pearson Vue.
- h. State Certification
 - i. Successfully pass the NREMT Exam and obtain certification.
 - ii. Submit application fee (\$75.00*), Background (includes a fee), current BLS CPR card, and present your NREMT Certification.

2. Program Expectations

- a. Strict Attendance requirements. **Cannot** miss more than 12 hours total.
- b. Must pass **all** Block Exams with a 73% or better.
- c. Requires several hours per week of out of class study time.
- d. Tests are completed online during class.
- e. Uniform & Equipment Requirements
 - i. Navy blue or black pants (no jeans; workpants preferred), Red polo shirt (Uniform Station), and black boots.
 - ii. Stethoscope (single tube preferred)
 - iii. Second hand watch
 - iiii. Trauma Scissors
 - iv. Black Belt
 - vi. Pen light
 - vii. UNM Student Badge
- f. EMS 151: Clinical/Field is an additional 72-90 days upon completion of EMS 180 and EMS 143.

EMT Intermediate Requirement Checklist

ALL WILL NEED TO BE SENT BY EMAIL

All requirements are to be completed and submitted 14 days after the 1st day of class begins.

- Current NM EMT Basic License.
- Current CPR- Healthcare Provider Level Card
- Current Driver's License or State Issued Picture ID Card
- Current Health Insurance Card
 - Medicaid is an acceptable insurance.
 - If you are registered with a Native American Tribe and you utilize the I.H.S. facility for all your medical care and emergencies; a letter stating this and proof of your registered membership will be accepted as your Health Insurance.
 - Contact Sonya Damon for the Letter Template.
- 10-Panel Illegal Drug Urinalysis
 - Testing can be performed no more than 30 days prior to the 1st day of class.
 - Takes 7 – 10 days for the results.
 - Can be performed at:
 - RMCH- College Clinic- (505) 863-7000
 - Indian Health Services (your area I.H.S.):
 - selected service. Not all I.H.S. facilities will provide this service.
- Completed Background Check (\$73.30)
 - Requisition for Background check will be given during EMS Orientation.
 - **DO NOT PERFORM BEFORE PRIOR TO THE EMS ORIENTATION.**
- Immunizations (see attached Immunization Requirements for UNM Students in Healthcare Programs)
 - Records must have the name of the facility where immunizations were administered.

PLEASE PROVIDE ALL AND ANY DOCUMENTATIONS (RESULTS, ANYTHING WITH SIGNATURES, RECEIPTS, LAB ORDER FORMS, etc.) SHOWING IN PROGRESS TO SONYA DAMON, EMS DIRECTOR.
