Ralph Casebolt regarding By Laws and Constitution Approval: A draft of by-laws of standing committees was distributed for review. Sought faculty opinion on a couple of items- question: (1) Should we change language from "department" to "division" in by-laws to be consistent with the Constitution itself? General agreement that we should change it to divisions; (2) Changing one of the committees from a four to a three year term to be consistent with Constitution? General agreement to change to 3; (3) Leave furloughed committees as-is and eliminate disbanded committees? General agreement is to do so.

Report from Committees:

AMATYC committee has finished its first round of competition.

Mini-grants committee has \$7500 to dole out. A form will be distributed next week. Dr. Huang will provide further information.

Curriculum committee progress is reported in a hand-out that was available at this meeting.
