## **Academic Requirements for Candidates**

- Must be an enrolled student with a minimum of 6 credit hours with UNM and attending class at the Gallup Branch Campus
- ✤ Must not be on academic, disciplinary, or financial probation
- ♦ Must be able to serve for a term of one (1) academic year
- For the Secretary, Treasurer and Senator position: Returning students must have an accumulative grade point average of 2.5 or great; new students are not held to grade point average qualification
- For President and Vice-President position: Returning students must have an accumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater; new students are not held to a grade point average qualification.
- Current understanding of the 2018 revision Student Senate Bylaws and Student Handbook by Application deadline
