TRIO Student Support Services is a federally funded grant program designed to assist eligible students in overcoming barriers in obtaining a college education.

Eligibility Criteria

- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Enroll at UNM-Gallup
- Have an Academic Need

Eligible Candidates Must Also Meet One or a Combination of:

- First-Generation College Student
- Meet Federal Income Guidelines
- Possess a documented physical or learning disability

Note: A first-generation college student is defined as a student whose parent(s)/legal guardian(s) have not completed a bachelor's degree by your 18th birthday

Eligibility does not guarantee acceptance into the program. Only a limited number of students may receive program services, according to grant regulations.

OUR SERVICES

TRIO/SSS Program serves 160 students, which allows staff to work intensively with students in the areas of academic choice. One-on-one interaction builds personal and professional relationships with students. The SSS Staff serves as advocates, navigators, supporters, and resources to our students. In our positive and supportive academic community, SSS collaborates with students to strengthen their self-efficacy as they strive towards the successful completion of their post-secondary education and help students to make the transition from one level of higher education to the next.
