#### **The Funded Participant Criterion**

Approved: **160** participants Served: **162** participants

#### A. Persistence Rate

Approved: 67% of all participants served in the reporting year by the SSS project will persist from one academic year to the beginning of the next academic year or earn an associate's degree or certificate at the grantee institution and/or transfer from a 2-year to a 4-year by the fall term of the next academic year.

Actual: The UNM-G Student Support Services Program's 2015-2016 persistence rate was <u>86%</u>; 19 percentage points above the stated objective.

#### B. Good Academic Standing

**Approved:** <u>75%</u> of all enrolled SSS participants served will meet the performance level required to stay in good academic standing at the grantee institution.

Actual: The UNM-G student Support Services Program's 2015-2016 good academic standing rate was <u>94%</u>; 19 percentage points above the stated objective.

## C.1. Associate's Degree or Certificate Attainment for 2012 -2013 Cohort

Approved: <u>15%</u> of new participants served each year will graduate with an Associate's Degree or Certificate within four (4) years.

Actual: 31%; 16 percentage points above the stated objective

C.2. Associate's Degree or Certificate Attainment and

Transfer from a 2-year to a 4-year Institution for 2012-2013

Cohort

Approved: 10% of new participants served each year will receive an associate's degree or certificate from the grantee institution and transfer to a four-year institution within four (4) years.

Actual: 24%; 14 percentage points above the stated objective
