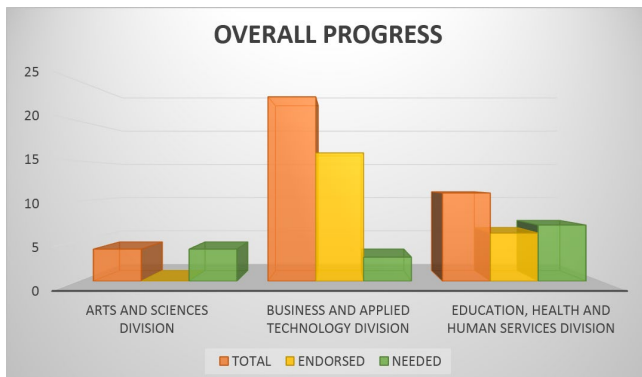


UNM Gallup Faculty Senate Report

Program Assessment Plan Update: Attached in the spreadsheet called

“UpdatedUNMProgramAssessmentInfo.xlsx” is updated list of all the program assessment plans status for our campus. As specified by accreditation, all the program assessment plans submitted are housed on the UNM Gallup website at url <http://www.gallup.unm.edu/vert/faculty-staff/assessment.php>. Dr. Mitchell is requesting for the Fall 2014 – Spring 2015 program assessment reports however our CARC members had to start from scratch. As of fall 2015, OUR UNMG CARC had to define our internal assessment process and develop assessment information which is now housed on our UNMG Assessment webpage. Moving forward, the CARC members need to request for the Fall2015-Spring 2016 assessment reports for the academic year due internally May 15, 2016.
